"AN ACT CONCERNING GAMING."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) For purposes of this section,
4 "Mashantucket Pequot compact" means the Tribal-State Compact
5 between the Mashantucket Pequot Tribe and the state of Connecticut,
6 as incorporated and amended in the Final Mashantucket Pequot
7 Gaming Procedures prescribed by the Secretary of the United States
8 Department of the Interior pursuant to Section 2710(d)(7)(B)(vii) of
9 Title 25 of the United States Code and published in 56 Federal Register
10 24996 (May 31, 1991), and "Mohegan compact" means the Tribal-State
11 Compact between the Mohegan Tribe of Indians of Connecticut and
12 the state of Connecticut, dated May 17, 1994.

13 (b) The tribal business entity may not establish a casino gaming
14 facility in the state of Connecticut until the United States Bureau of
15 Indian Affairs approves the following: (1) The joint memorandum of

16 understanding entered into by and between the state of Connecticut
 17 and the Mashantucket Pequot Tribe on January 13, 1993, as amended
 18 on April 30, 1993, (2) the joint memorandum of understanding entered
 19 into by and between the state of Connecticut and the Mohegan Tribe of
 20 Indians of Connecticut on May 17, 1994, (3) any amendment to the
 21 Mashantucket Pequot compact or memorandum of understanding
 22 entered into by and between the state of Connecticut and the
 23 Mashantucket Pequot Tribe concerning the operation of a casino
 24 gaming facility by the tribal business entity in the state of Connecticut,
 25 and (4) any amendment to the Mohegan compact or memorandum of
 26 understanding entered into by and between the state of Connecticut
 27 and the Mohegan Tribe of Indians of Connecticut concerning the
 28 operation of a casino gaming facility by the tribal business entity in the
 29 state of Connecticut."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Sec. 501	<i>from passage</i>	New section
