"AN ACT CONCERNING GAMING."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The tribal business entity
4 shall annually contribute four hundred thousand dollars to nonprofit
5 organizations primarily concerned with the treatment and
6 rehabilitation of compulsive gamblers in the state.

7 Sec. 502. Section 12-818 of the general statutes is repealed and the
8 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

9 For each of the fiscal years ending June 30, 2010, and June 30, 2011,
10 the Connecticut Lottery Corporation shall transfer one million nine
11 hundred thousand dollars of the revenue received from the sale of
12 lottery tickets to the chronic gamblers treatment rehabilitation account
13 created pursuant to section 17a-713. For the fiscal years ending June 30,
14 2012, to June 30, 2013, inclusive, the Connecticut Lottery Corporation

15 shall transfer one million nine hundred thousand dollars of the
 16 revenue received from the sale of lottery tickets to the chronic
 17 gamblers treatment rehabilitation account created pursuant to section
 18 17a-713. For the fiscal [year] years ending June 30, 2014, and [each
 19 fiscal year thereafter] June 30, 2015, the Connecticut Lottery
 20 Corporation shall transfer two million three hundred thousand dollars
 21 of the revenue received from the sale of lottery tickets to the chronic
 22 gamblers treatment rehabilitation account created pursuant to section
 23 17a-713. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, and each fiscal year
 24 thereafter, the Connecticut Lottery Corporation shall transfer two
 25 million seven hundred thousand dollars of the revenue received from
 26 the sale of lottery tickets to the chronic gamblers treatment
 27 rehabilitation account created pursuant to section 17a-713."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
