"AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS TO COMPLETE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS RELATED TO MENTAL HEALTH CONDITIONS COMMON TO VETERANS AND FAMILY MEMBERS OF VETERANS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 14-20b of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2015*):

5 (a) The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, at the request of any
6 veteran or member of the armed forces, as defined in subsection (a) of
7 section 27-103, including any person who served on active duty in the
8 armed forces for training purposes only and received an honorable
9 discharge therefrom, or the surviving spouse of such veteran or
10 member, shall register any motor vehicle owned or leased for a period
11 of at least one year by such person and shall issue a special certificate

12 of registration and a set of number plates for each such vehicle. The
 13 plates shall expire and be renewed as provided in section 14-22. The
 14 commissioner shall charge a fee for such plates which shall cover the
 15 entire cost of making the same and which shall be in addition to the fee
 16 for registration of such motor vehicle.

17 (b) Any such member of the armed forces who is dishonorably
 18 discharged shall return such plates to the commissioner not later than
 19 thirty days after such discharge. The commissioner shall not renew
 20 such plates for any motor vehicle owned or leased by any such
 21 member of the armed forces who is dishonorably discharged."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
