"AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL ETHICS TASK FORCE."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 9-622 of the general statutes is amended by adding
4 subdivision (17) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

5 (NEW) (17) Any employee of the General Assembly who is a
6 manager or member of a limited liability company that provides
7 consultant or other professional services for campaign activities to any
8 candidate or committee, as those terms are defined in section 9-601.

9 Sec. 502. Subsection (a) of section 9-623 of the general statutes is
10 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
11 *passage*):

12 (a) Any person who violates subdivision (17) of section 9-622, as
13 amended by this act, or who knowingly and wilfully violates any other
14 provision of this chapter shall be guilty of a class D felony. The

15 Secretary of the State or the town clerk shall notify the State Elections
16 Enforcement Commission of any such violation of which said secretary
17 or such town clerk may have knowledge. Any such fine for a violation
18 of any provision of this chapter applying to the office of the Treasurer
19 shall be deposited on a pro rata basis in any trust funds, as defined in
20 section 3-13c, affected by such violation."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Sec. 502	<i>from passage</i>	9-623(a)
