**"AN ACT LIMITING DEALER CONVEYANCE FEES."**

- 1 Strike section 3 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:
- 2 "Sec. 3. (*Effective July 1, 2015*) (a) Not later than November 1, 2015,
- 3 each new car dealer and used car dealer licensed under section 14-52 of
- 4 the general statutes, and continuously in business during the period
- 5 from October 1, 2014, to September 30, 2015, shall provide to the
- 6 Department of Motor Vehicles the following information: (1) The
- 7 average amount charged by each dealer as a dealer conveyance fee or
- 8 processing fee in each month of the year commencing October 1, 2014,
- 9 and ending September 30, 2015; (2) a description of how such fee was
- 10 calculated, and the reason for any month-to-month variations in such
- 11 fee; and (3) the name and address of the dealer and whether such
- 12 dealer is a new car dealer, a used car dealer or both. For purposes of
- 13 this section, "dealer conveyance fee" or "processing fee" has the same
- 14 meaning as provided in section 14-62 of the general statutes, as

15 amended by this act.

16 (b) The Department of Motor Vehicles shall facilitate the submission  
17 of information described in subsection (a) of this section by (1)  
18 publicizing the requirements of this section, (2) developing and  
19 distributing a form for such submission, except there shall be no  
20 requirement that such form be used, provided, if such form is not  
21 used, the information is submitted in a manner and form that  
22 reasonably conforms to the requirements of subsection (a) of this  
23 section, (3) allowing such submission either by mail or electronic mail,  
24 and (4) taking any follow-up steps necessary to ensure complete and  
25 accurate reporting of such information.

26 (c) The Department of Motor Vehicles shall, not later than January  
27 15, 2016, report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of  
28 the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General  
29 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to transportation.  
30 Such report shall be a compilation of the information submitted  
31 pursuant to this section and shall include a description of the  
32 methodology used to collect and report such information."
