"AN ACT REGULATING TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANIES."

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- 1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:
- 3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a task force
4 to study the availability in the state of wheelchair accessible vehicles,
5 and other transportation options for persons with disabilities.
- 6 (b) The task force shall consist of the following members:
- 7 (1) Two appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives;
- 8 (2) Two appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;
- 9 (3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of
10 Representatives;

- 11 (4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate;
- 12 (5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of
13 Representatives;
- 14 (6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate;
- 15 (7) The Commissioner of Transportation, or the commissioner's
16 designee and the director of the Office of Protection and Advocacy for
17 Persons with Disabilities; and
- 18 (8) A representative from the Board of Education and Services to the
19 Blind, and a representative from the Commission on the Deaf and
20 Hearing Impaired.
- 21 (c) Any member of the task force appointed under subdivision (1),
22 (2), (3), (4), (5) or (6) of subsection (b) of this section may be a member
23 of the General Assembly.
- 24 (d) All appointments to the task force shall be made not later than
25 thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy shall be
26 filled by the appointing authority.
- 27 (e) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president
28 pro tempore of the Senate shall select the chairpersons of the task force
29 from among the members of the task force. Such chairpersons shall
30 schedule the first meeting of the task force, which shall be held not
31 later than sixty days after the effective date of this section.
- 32 (f) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the
33 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
34 transportation shall serve as administrative staff of the task force.
- 35 (g) Not later than January 1, 2016, the task force shall submit a
36 report on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing
37 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
38 relating to transportation, in accordance with the provisions of section

39 11-4a of the general statutes. The task force shall terminate on the date
40 that it submits such report or January 1, 2016, whichever is later."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
