**"AN ACT CONCERNING DNA TESTING FOR PERSONS

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2015*) Beginning with the
4 session of the General Assembly commencing on February 3, 2016,
5 upon the request of any member of the General Assembly, the Office of
6 Legislative Research and the Office of Fiscal Analysis shall jointly
7 prepare an equity impact statement with respect to any bill or
8 amendment that could, if passed, have a disparate impact on a
9 municipality within the state based on demographic factors relating to
10 the composition of the municipality, including, but not limited to, race,
11 ethnicity, gender, income and education level, and persons with
12 disabilities."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
