"AN ACT CONCERNING THE FORECLOSURE MEDIATION PROGRAM."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Joint Committee on Legislative
4 Management shall not operate the personal screening system that was
5 instituted in the Legislative Office Building and at the State Capitol in
6 2014 unless either: (1) The National Terrorism Advisory System issues
7 an imminent threat alert, which warns of a credible, specific and
8 impending threat against the United States, or (2) the majority and
9 minority leaders of the House of Representatives, the majority and
10 minority leaders of the Senate, the speaker of the House of
11 Representatives and the president pro tempore of the Senate, after
12 consultation with the chief of the Office of the State Capitol Police, by
13 two-thirds vote, authorize the operation of said system on any given
14 day and only for as long as warranted by such alert or authorized by
15 said legislators."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
