The Connecticut Conference of Municipalities (CCM) is Connecticut's statewide association of towns and cities and the voice of local government - your partners in governing Connecticut. Our members represent 156 towns and cities and over 96% of Connecticut's population. We appreciate the opportunity to testify on bills of interest to towns and cities.

SB 1045, "An Act Concerning Municipal Plans Of Conservation and Development"

CCM opposes SB 1045.

SB 1045 would require towns and cities to include in any new plans of conservation and development to designate the existing and planned sewer service and avoidance areas within the municipality.

This would add additional costs to municipalities to when they make changes to local their Plans of Conservation and Development. Additionally, the requirement that any plans adopted after July 1, 2015 would have to include these expanded requirements would be problematic and costly for towns and cities that are already in the process of updating these local plans.

CCM urges the Committee to take no action on SB 1045.
