

To Senator Gerratana, Representative Ritter and members of the Public Health Committee: I write to urge you to vote in favor of Bill HB5914, concerning the practice of Classical Homeopathy. I am 87 years old and have used Homeopathic medicine all my life, along with traditional western medicine. When I recently moved to Connecticut I was shocked to learn that Board Certified Homeopathic Caregivers were not allowed to practice in the State.
