

To the Connecticut Public Health Committee,

I am writing to you to express my support of having fully certified homeopathy practitioners being legal to practice in our beautiful State of Connecticut. We deserve to have affordable options to our health care system.

With medicines so expensive, we should be able to turn to more natural ways of treatments. Homeopathy is a very affordable, safe and effective way of assisting the body to recover from an ailment. These are nationally accredited, board certified practitioners who are allowed to practice in other states, such as Massachusetts. Our law is antiquated in that it is from 1893.
