To all those wanting access to ANY nationally-certified healthcare practitioner in CT,

I am a licensed Massage Therapist with a 20-year practice in Bethel, CT. It is essential to me to have access to nationally-certified homeopathic practitioners in my home state of Connecticut for the following reasons:

1. I was diagnosed by a Medical doctor with uterine cancer in 2002. I did not have health insurance at the time, which did not matter to me; I did not want to use the only kind of medical "treatment" that insurance would cover, the traditional chemotherapy and radiation. The first homeopath I worked with (who also had a medical license) did help my condition to improve somewhat. But I felt I needed to work with a practitioner with a more classic homeopathic approach. Thanks to that practitioner, not only am I alive and healthy today, I was able to maintain a light work schedule throughout my healing process. It would have been a much more difficult and slower process if I had to add the time and distance to travel out of state for that therapy.
2. As a licensed massage practitioner, I want to be able to offer my clients recommendations for homeopathic practitioners here in CT. They need to have easy access to health care modalities in which they can take a more active part in their health maintenance.
3. When I first started into Massage in 1982, there was no licensure law in CT. I am thankful that a law has been established so that I can be confident that any licensed massage practitioner I go to has a high standard of qualification. The same should be true of the practice of Homeopathy.
4. Having the ability to make choices, that are easily accessible, is a BIG PART in the healing process itself.

I recognize that medically trained doctors have a valuable role in society. But even with their standards, not all of them are qualified, no matter what state they are licensed in. Thankfully there are enough choices of Medical doctors within CT so anyone can find a better qualified one. All need the same access to homeopathy.

Please do not allow this state to be held to antiquated laws that hinder progress in recognizing standardized, complementary health modalities such as Classic Homeopathy.
