






### COMMISSION FOR CHILD SUPPORT GUIDELINES

We, Rachel A. Pencu, Esq. and David W. Griffin, Esq., Co-Chairs of the Commission for Child Support Guidelines, hereby certify that:

1. In compliance with Conn. Gen. Stat. section 4-168(a)(1), on July 31, 2013, the Commission for Child Support Guidelines gave notice by posting a notice on the eRegulations System of its intention to adopt regulations regarding Connecticut Child Support and Arrearage Guidelines. A copy of the notice is attached as Exhibit A.
2. In compliance with Conn. Gen. Stat. section 4-168(a)(2), the Commission for Child Support Guidelines gave notice electronically to each joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of the subject matter of the proposed regulation. A copy of the notice is attached as Exhibit B.
3. In compliance with Conn. Gen. Stat. section 4-168(a)(3), the Commission for Child Support Guidelines gave notice electronically or provided paper copies to all persons who made requests for advance notice of its regulation-making proceedings.
4. In compliance with Conn. Gen. Stat. section 4-168(a)(4), the Commission for Child Support Guidelines provided paper copies of electronic versions of the proposed regulations to all persons who requested them.
5. In compliance with Conn. Gen. Stat. section 4-168(a)(5), the Commission for Child Support Guidelines prepared a fiscal note, including an estimate of the cost or of the revenue impact of the proposed regulations (A) on the state or any municipality of the state, and (B) on small business in the state, include an estimate of the number of small businesses subject to the proposed regulation and the projected costs, including but not limited to, reporting, recordkeeping and administrative, associated with compliance with the proposed regulation and, if applicable, the regulatory flexibility analysis prepared under Conn. Gen. Stat. section 4-168a. A copy of the fiscal note is attached as Exhibit C.
6. All interested persons were given reasonable opportunity to submit data, views or arguments, orally at a hearing if granted under Conn. Gen. Stat. section 4-168(a) or in writing, concerning the proposed regulations and to inspect and copy or view online and print the fiscal note referred to in paragraph (5) above.

7. On the following dates, persons were allowed to present oral argument concerning the proposed regulations: September 17, 2013, September 24, 2013, October 1, 2013, October 8, 2013, and October 15, 2013.
8. The Commission for Child Support Guidelines considered fully all written and oral submissions respecting the proposed regulations.
9. The Commission for Child Support Guidelines revised the fiscal note to indicate changes made in the proposed regulations. A copy of the revised fiscal note is attached as Exhibit D.
10. In compliance with Conn. Gen. Stat. section 4-168(d), on October 9, 2014, the Commission for Child Support Guidelines posted on the eRegulations System and sent to all persons who have made submissions or who have made statements or oral arguments concerning the proposed regulation and who have requested notification, notice that it decided to take action on the proposed regulation and has made available for copying and inspection pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act: (A) The final wording of the proposed regulation; (B) a statement of the principal reasons in support of its intended action; and (C) a statement of the principal considerations in opposition to its intended action as urged in written or oral comments on the proposed regulation and its reasons for rejecting such considerations. A copy of the notice is attached as Exhibit E.
