Enclosed please find regulations concerning Motor Fuel Price Posting. I am submitting these regulations, attached as Exhibit A, to you for approval in accordance with Section 4-169 of the Connecticut General Statutes. Please contact Jerry Padula at 860/713-6087, if you should have any questions.

- 1) On May 25, 2014, the Department of Consumer Protection published notice of its intention to amend the regulations with the Secretary of the State. A copy of said notice is attached hereto as Exhibit B.
- 2) On October 7, 2014, a Fiscal Note was prepared by Consumer Protection. A true copy of said fiscal note is attached hereto as Exhibit C.
- 3) On October 7, 2014, a Small Business Impact Statement was prepared. A true copy of said statement is hereto attached as Exhibit D.
- 4) On or about April 30, 2014, letters went to the DECD, General Law and Commerce Committees, notifying of the department's intention to amend the regulations, and of the public hearing scheduled for August 29, 2014 (attached as Exhibit E).
- 5) Pursuant to 4-168, the Department prepared a Notice of Decision to take action on the proposed regulation. Attached hereto is a copy of said Notice for publishing, along with a Summary of Testimony and the hearing transcript (Exhibit F).


Please review the regulations for legal sufficiency and promptly return them to my office so that I may file them with the Legislative Regulation Review Committee. Thank you.






