

PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED DEPARTMENT OF LABOR REGULATIONS

March 24, 2015

Anne FF Rugens: Good morning. My name is Anne Rugens, and I'm an attorney with the Connecticut Department of Labor's Office of Program Policy. Today is March 24, 2015 and the time is approximately 8:35 a.m. This hearing is taking place in the Office of Program Policy, in the Connecticut Department of Labor. The hearing this morning is regarding the Department's proposed incorporation by reference of federal OSHA's modifications to the standard pertaining to Cranes and Derricks in Construction:Operator Certification, which was published in the Federal Register on September 26, 2014.

Notice of the proposed regulations and of this public hearing on the regulations was published on the Secretary of the State's website on February 20, 2015. Notice was further provided that interested parties would be able to submit data, facts, views or arguments orally or in writing at this hearing and would have 30 days from the publication of the regulations to submit written argument to my attention in the Office of Program Policy, DOL.
