Please accept this letter as a withdrawal of the proposed regulations cited above. According to Legislative Regulation Review Committee 2015 to 2016 Rules:

(12) (a) An agency may withdraw a proposed regulation from consideration by submitting an electronic notification of withdrawal to the Committee, prior to the convening of the meeting at which the Committee is scheduled to consider the regulation. Any regulation that is withdrawn prior to the convening of the meeting at which the Committee is scheduled to consider the regulation shall be treated as a new proposed regulation, for the purposes of section 4-170 of the Connecticut general statutes, when the agency next submits such regulation to the Committee. ...
