


Fishing License Fees and Age that Defines "Senior Citizen"



Northeast States

Angler fees for ages 65 and older

-  Discounted
-  Discounted until 70 then is free

Standard adult and senior fishing license fees for the northeast states.

State	Standard (full-price) Inland Fishing License Fee & ages*	Age to qualify for senior citizen license	Fees for senior citizens
CT	18-64: \$28	65+	Free
DE	16-64: \$11	65+	exempt from license requirement.
MA	18-64: \$27.50	65+	age 65-69: \$16.25. age 70+: Free
MD	16-64: \$20.50	65+	\$5.00 annual fee
ME	16-69: \$25	70+	\$8 –one-time fee
NH	16-67: \$35	68+	Free
NJ	16-64: \$22.50	65+	age 65-69: \$12.50, age 70+: Free
NY	16-69: \$25	70+	\$5.00 annual fee
PA	16-64: \$21.70	65+	\$11.70 annual fee (or \$51.70 lifetime fee)
RI	15-64: \$18	65+	Free
VA	16-64: \$23	65+	\$9.00 annual fee
VT	18+: \$25	65+	\$50 permanent (lifetime) license
WV	18-64: \$19	65+	\$25 permanent (lifetime) license

*Note that the ages shown here are the age at which the full-price fee applies, several states, including CT have discounted license fees for anglers younger than these ages (in CT ages 16-17 are 50% of full-price).
