I would like to comment on the following proposed bills:

HB5054 is unacceptable to me. Seizing firearms and ammunition without a hearing is unjust. I ask you to vote no on this bill.

HB5622 using erased records to determine if a person should be ineligible to get a firearm would be similar to charging someone again for a crime they were acquitted of in the past. I oppose this bill and ask you to vote no

SB 429/442/5623 These three bills all seem to allow seizing weapons and ammunition from a person who has a legal right to carry. Accusations should not be the determining factor in stripping a persons second amendment right to bear arms. This gives too much power to the accuser and exposes the accused to abuse based solely on hearsay. If both sides are not allowed to be heard then no action should be taken.
