Please accept this as my testimony (for Public Hearing held on 2/24/16) in **SUPPORT of HB 5344, An Act Concerning Support for Animals that are neglected or Treated Cruelly.**

I vote, and this issue is important to me.

I support HB 5433 because:

Research has established strong links between violent behaviors towards humans and violent behaviors toward animals.

Law enforcement agencies must take violence towards animals seriously, and prosecutions must be encouraged. A disturbing OLR report (2015-R-0262) found that between 2005 and 2015, 80% of animal cruelty offences were not prosecuted or dismissed.

Having court advocates for animals would be done at no cost by enlisting volunteer representation for animals Law Students and Law Firms.

Teaching Humans to behave with kindness and respect towards animals will help build a more humane society.
