Dear Co-Chair Coleman, Co-Chair Tong, and Honorable Members of the Judiciary Committee,

This is an important issue for me, and I vote.

Please accept this as my testimony (for public hearing held on 2/24/16) in SUPPORT of HB 5344, An Act Concerning Support for Animals that are Neglected or Treated Cruelly.

I support HB 5344 because:

- Research has shown strong links between violent behaviors toward humans and violent behaviors toward animals.
- Law enforcement agencies must take violence toward animals seriously, and prosecutions must be encouraged. A disturbing OLR report (2015-R-0262) found that between 2005-15, 80% of animal cruelty offenses were either not prosecuted or dismissed.
- Having court advocates for animals would be done at no cost by enlisting volunteer representation for animals from law students and law firms.
- Teaching humans to behave with kindness and respect toward animals will help to build a more humane society.
