Dear Co-Chair Coleman, Co-Chair Tong, and Honorable Members of the Judiciary Committee,

Please accept this as my testimony (for public hearing held on 2/24/16) in **SUPPORT of HB 5344**, An Act Concerning Support for Animals that are Neglected or Treated Cruelly.

I vote, and this issue is important to me.

I support HB 5344 because:

- * Research has established strong links between violent behaviors toward humans and violent behaviors toward animals.
- * Law enforcement agencies must take violence toward animals seriously, and prosecutions must be encouraged. A disturbing OLR report (2015-R-0262) found that between 2005-15, 80% of animal cruelty offenses were either not prosecuted or dismissed.
- * Having court advocates for animals would be done at no cost by enlisting volunteer representation for animals from law students and law firms.
- * Teaching humans to behave with kindness and respect toward animals will help to build a more humane society.
