I'm contacting you today to tell you that I Amanda Sedor, resident of East Granby, CT would like you to support bill SB422. It is imperative that we protect residents and local farms during a drought not water bottlers. If the DPH declares there to be a Drought export of bottled water from CT needs to cease. I can not support water rate discounts for water bottlers while citizens pay more and are forced to conserve. I would like the Special Sewer Service Charge discount for water bottlers rescinded, now known as the Clean Water Project Charge. Why should corporations receive a discount when its CT residents who have paid for years to build infrastructure for clean water. There really should be a citizen MDC committee to prevent this type of problematic legislation from happening in the future. I would ask that there be a moratorium on any new large water agreements of this time (e.g. anything over 250,000 gallons per day) until the State Water Plan is compiled and this issue is addressed. I support bill SB422.
