To members of the Public Safety and Security Committee of the CT Legislature:

I wanted to voice my support for SB 20 which will change the definition of carrying a firearm when intoxicated by reducing the prohibited ratio of alcohol in the blood to eight-hundredths of one per cent or more of alcohol. The current standard defines the prohibited blood level ratio at ten-hundredths of 1%. Eight-hundredths of 1% would be consistent with the driving while intoxicated standard.

I think this a reasonable change because it has been scientifically proved that alcohol impairs judgement and the combination of guns and alcohol puts the public at greater risk.

The approval of this bill is critical in honoring the public's right to shop, live, and go about their business in a climate of relative safety and security.
