AN ACT REDUCING THE TAX RATE APPLICABLE TO CERTAIN JEWELRY AND CLOTHING SALES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subparagraph (H) of subdivision (1) of section 12-408 of the
- 2 general statutes be amended to reduce the rate of sales and use taxes
- 3 on jewelry sales exceeding five thousand dollars and clothing sales
- 4 exceeding one thousand dollars from seven and three-fourths per cent
- 5 to seven per cent.

Statement of Purpose:

To revitalize consumer buying by reducing the sales tax on certain jewelry and clothing sales.
