AN ACT CONCERNING BOATING SAFETY ON CANDLEWOOD LAKE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2016*) On the waters of
2 Candlewood Lake, including Squantz Pond, no person shall operate a
3 vessel in excess of fifteen miles per hour from eleven o'clock p.m. to
4 sunrise. The provisions of this section may be enforced by any law
5 enforcement officer or lake patrolman authorized to enforce the
6 boating regulations of the Department of Energy and Environmental
7 Protection. Any fine or penalty imposed as a result of a violation of the
8 provisions of this section shall be in accordance with the provisions of
9 said regulations.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
