***AN ACT MAKING MINOR REVISIONS TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE  
GENERAL STATUTES REGARDING COMMERCIAL KENNEL  
SERVICES ADVERTISEMENTS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 22-344 of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*  
3 *passage*):

4 (a) (1) No person shall maintain a commercial kennel or offer the  
5 services of a commercial kennel, as defined in section 22-327, until he  
6 or she has obtained from the commissioner a license to maintain [such]  
7 a commercial kennel under such regulations as the commissioner  
8 provides as to sanitation, disease and humane treatment of dogs or  
9 cats and the protection of the public safety. Upon written application  
10 and the payment of a fee of two hundred dollars, the commissioner  
11 shall issue such license to be effective until the ensuing December  
12 thirty-first provided the commissioner finds (A) that such regulations  
13 have been complied with, and (B) in the case of each initial application  
14 for such license, that the zoning enforcement official of the  
15 municipality wherein such kennel is to be maintained has certified that
