AN ACT INCREASING THE FINES FOR LITTERING AND ILLEGAL DUMPING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 22a-250 of the general statutes be amended to increase
- 2 the maximum fine that may be imposed for littering and illegal
- 3 dumping to one thousand dollars and that the state be allowed to
- 4 retain all, or a portion of, the increased fine.

Statement of Purpose:

To improve the deterrent effect of fines with regard to persons who engage in littering and illegal dumping.
