AN ACT REQUIRING INSTRUCTIONS FOR DIALING 9-1-1 ON OR ADJACENT TO CERTAIN MULTILINE TELEPHONES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2016) Any business firm, as
2 defined in section 12-631 of the general statutes, or state agency, as
3 defined in section 1-79 of the general statutes, that uses a multiline
4 telephone system that cannot directly access the enhanced 9-1-1 service
5 by dialing or otherwise accessing the three digits "9-1-1" shall
6 prominently display instructions on how to access the enhanced 9-1-1
7 service on or adjacent to each telephone connected to such multiline
8 telephone system.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To require business firms and state agencies to display instructions on how to dial 9-1-1 on or adjacent to certain multiline telephones.
