AN ACT PERMITTING THE SALE OF PRIVATELY HELD ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR FOR AUCTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2016*) Notwithstanding any
2 provision of title 30 of the general statutes, an owner of alcoholic
3 liquor, other than the holder of an alcoholic liquor permit issued
4 pursuant to title 30 of the general statutes, may sell or transfer
5 ownership of the alcoholic liquor to the holder of an alcoholic liquor
6 permit issued pursuant to title 30 of the general statutes that allows the
7 permit holder to resell the alcoholic liquor at auction.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
