***AN ACT REQUIRING THE STUDY OF THE USE OF TECHNOLOGY IN THE STATE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2016*) (a) The chairperson of the Public  
2 Utilities Regulatory Authority shall conduct a study regarding the use  
3 of technology in the state.

4 (b) Not later than July 1, 2017, the chairperson of the Public Utilities  
5 Regulatory Authority, in accordance with section 11-4a of the general  
6 statutes, shall report the results of the study conducted pursuant to  
7 subsection (a) of this section to the joint standing committee of the  
8 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to energy and  
9 technology.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
