AN ACT CONCERNING THE MILITARY DEPARTMENT'S NONDISCRIMINATION LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 27-59 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):
- 3 [No] Subject to federal law or regulation governing membership in
- 4 the National Guard, no person shall be denied membership in the
- 5 armed forces of the state, nor be discriminated against in the matter of
- 6 promotion therein, on account of [his race, creed or color] such
- 7 person's religion, national origin, color, race, sex, gender identity or
- 8 <u>expression or sexual orientation</u>. No units of such organizations shall
- 9 be formed, and no separate types of duties or separate
- 10 accommodations shall be assigned, in such a manner as to result in the
- 11 segregation of members thereof on account of [race, creed or color]
- 12 religion, national origin, color, race, sex, gender identity or expression

- or sexual orientation, except that accommodations may be assigned
- 14 consistent with any federal military regulation or service policy.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
