AN ACT CONCERNING THE LABELLING OF FARM STAND EGGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 22-47 of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

3 Producers selling eggs of their own producing direct to household
4 users are exempt from the provisions of this part provided such eggs
5 are not falsely labeled or adulterated, as described in section 22-45. All
6 types of shippers selling eggs to a first receiver who will grade them
7 into the proper size and grade before reselling are exempt from the
8 provisions of this part.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	22-47

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that all eggs are acceptable for consumption, regardless of their source.
