AN ACT CONCERNING THE DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 8-37s of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2016*):

3 (a) The Commissioner of Housing shall monitor the progress of the
4 public and private sector toward meeting housing needs and shall
5 collect and annually publish data on housing production in the state.
6 In order to ensure a steady flow of information for the purposes of this
7 section, all municipalities shall submit to the commissioner a copy of
8 the monthly federal Bureau of the Census report on building permits
9 issued and public construction filed at the same time as such report is
10 filed with the federal Bureau of the Census.

11 (b) Pursuant to 24 CFR 5.150 to 5.180, inclusive, sections 8-37cc and
12 8-37ee and the reporting requirements of sections 8-37bb, 8-37ff, 8-
13 37qqq and this section, the commissioner shall promulgate regulations,
14 on or before June 30, 2017, setting forth the procedures the state will

15 follow in: (1) Preparing a comprehensive list of all state and federally
16 subsidized housing in the state; (2) conducting a housing needs
17 assessment by income levels pursuant to subsection (a) of this section;
18 and (3) establishing annual geographical targets that affirmatively
19 further fair housing, measuring the achievement of those targets, and
20 collecting, analyzing, and annually reporting outcomes of such
21 affirmative marketing. (A) The list of subsidized housing shall include
22 for each housing development: (i) The development's name; (ii)
23 location by physical address and census tract; (iii) affordability income
24 requirements; (iv) number of units; (v) number of bedrooms per unit;
25 (vi) population served, specifically elderly, nonage-restricted,
26 disability, or supportive housing; (vii) the program through which the
27 development is funded and the amount of funding provided; (viii) the
28 year of allocation; and (ix) the type of funding, specifically new
29 construction, substantial rehabilitation, loan, purchase or rental
30 assistance. (B) The annual report on outcomes of affirmative marketing
31 shall include information on current residents opting to participate in
32 the necessary survey by development name and identify the
33 development's physical address and census tract using individualized
34 identification numbers, rather than names, in order to protect privacy.
35 Such report shall include: (i) Head of household race; (ii) head of
36 household gender; (iii) ethnicity; (iv) family status, specifically number
37 of children and ages; (v) disability status; (vi) income range; and (vii)
38 marital status. The report shall state targets for affirmative marketing,
39 measure progress for those targets over one, five and ten-year periods
40 and define penalties for failure to comply with affirmative marketing
41 obligations. (C) The interagency council on affordable housing shall,
42 on or before December 31, 2016, prepare and submit to the General
43 Assembly, in accordance with section 11-4a, and the Department of
44 Housing, and post on its Internet web site, a report recommending a
45 procedure for collecting the data the Department of Housing requires
46 to fulfill its obligations to provide an annual comprehensive list of all
47 state and federally subsidized housing in the state under this
48 subsection.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
