AN ACT CONCERNING INSTALLERS OF RESIDENTIAL STAIR LIFTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (7) of section 20-330 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
3 *1, 2016*):

4 (7) "Elevator installation, repair and maintenance work" means the
5 installation, erection, maintenance and repair of (A) residential stair
6 lifts by a home improvement contractor registered under chapter 400,
7 (B) all types of elevators, dumb waiters, escalators, and moving walks,
8 and (C) all mechanical equipment, fittings, associated piping and
9 wiring from a source of supply brought to the equipment room by an
10 unlimited electrical contractor for all types of machines used to hoist or
11 convey persons or materials, but [does not include] not including
12 temporary hoisting machines used for hoisting materials in connection
13 with any construction job or project;

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To allow registered home improvement contractors to install residential stair lifts.
