AN ACT MAKING THE BUDGETS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT, THE CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM AND THE REGIONAL COMMUNITY-TECHNICAL COLLEGE SYSTEM AVAILABLE ONLINE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2016*) (a) On or before September
2 1, 2016, and annually thereafter, the Board of Trustees for The
3 University of Connecticut shall post on said university's Internet web
4 site the current operating budget of The University of Connecticut in
5 detail. Such budget detail shall include, but not be limited to: (1) Any
6 amounts appropriated from the General Fund, and (2) any amounts to
7 be paid from the tuition revenues of The University of Connecticut.
- 8 (b) On or before September 1, 2016, and annually thereafter, the
9 Board of Regents for Higher Education shall post on the Internet web
10 site of the Connecticut State University System the current operating
11 budget of said system in detail. Such budget detail shall include, but
12 not be limited to: (1) Any amounts appropriated from the General
13 Fund, and (2) any amounts to be paid from the tuition revenues of said

14 system.

15 (c) On or before September 1, 2016, and annually thereafter, the
16 Board of Regents for Higher Education shall post on the Internet web
17 site of the regional community-technical college system the current
18 operating budget of said system in detail. Such budget detail shall
19 include, but not be limited to: (1) Any amounts appropriated from the
20 General Fund, and (2) any amounts to be paid from the tuition
21 revenues of said system.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
