**"AN ACT ESTABLISHING AND FUNDING A STATE PARKS  
SUSTAINABILITY ACCOUNT."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 30-19f of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2016*):

5 (a) An in-state transporter's permit for alcoholic liquor shall allow  
6 the commercial transportation of any alcoholic liquor as permitted by  
7 law. The annual fee for an in-state transporter's liquor permit shall be  
8 one thousand two hundred fifty dollars.

9 (b) No person, corporation, trust, partnership, incorporated or  
10 unincorporated association, [and] or any other legal entity except: (1)  
11 The holder of an out-of-state shipper's permit issued pursuant to  
12 section 30-18 or 30-19; (2) the holder of a manufacturer's permit issued  
13 pursuant to section 30-16 other than the holder of a manufacturer's

14 permit for a farm winery; [and] or (3) the holder of a wholesaler's  
15 permit issued pursuant to section 30-17, shall transport any alcoholic  
16 beverages imported into this state unless such person, corporation,  
17 trust, partnership, incorporated or unincorporated association or other  
18 legal entity holds an in-state transporter's permit and the tax imposed  
19 on such alcoholic liquor by section 12-435 has been paid and, if  
20 applicable, the tax imposed on the sale of such alcoholic liquor  
21 pursuant to chapter 219 has been paid.

22 (c) An in-state transporter, when knowingly shipping or delivering  
23 wine directly to a consumer in this state, shall: (1) Ensure that the  
24 shipping labels on all containers of wine shipped directly to a  
25 consumer in this state conspicuously state the following: "CONTAINS  
26 ALCOHOL—SIGNATURE OF A PERSON AGE 21 OR OLDER  
27 REQUIRED FOR DELIVERY"; (2) obtain the signature of a person age  
28 twenty-one or older at the address prior to delivery, after requiring the  
29 signer to demonstrate that he or she is age twenty-one or older by  
30 providing a valid motor vehicle operator's license or a valid identity  
31 card described in section 1-1h; and (3) not ship to any address in the  
32 state where the sale of alcoholic liquor is prohibited by local option  
33 pursuant to section 30-9.

34 (d) Each holder of an in-state transporter's permit for alcoholic  
35 liquor issued pursuant to this section that knowingly transports  
36 alcoholic liquor into this state shall file a report with the Department of  
37 Revenue Services, in an electronic format prescribed by the  
38 Commissioner of Revenue Services, not later than the fifteenth day of  
39 the month following the month during which the transport is made.  
40 The report shall include the name of the person, corporation, trust,  
41 partnership, incorporated or unincorporated association or other legal  
42 entity filing the report, the period of time covered by the report, the  
43 name and business address of each consignor of the alcoholic liquor,  
44 the name and address of each consignee of the alcoholic liquor and the  
45 date of shipment or delivery of the alcoholic liquor. The Department of  
46 Revenue Services shall provide a copy of the report, upon written  
47 request, to the Liquor Control Commission and the Commissioner of

48 Consumer Protection.

49 (e) Notwithstanding any provisions of this section, all functions  
50 required of the Department of Revenue Services under this section  
51 shall be performed within available appropriations.

52 [(d)] (f) Any person convicted of violating [subsections] subsection  
53 (a), (b), [and] (c) or (d) of this section shall be fined not more than [two]  
54 one thousand dollars for each offense."
