**"AN ACT CREATING THE CONNECTICUT RETIREMENT SECURITY PROGRAM."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) No member of the  
4 Connecticut Retirement Security Authority board of directors or any  
5 executive director, assistant executive director or authorized officer  
6 appointed by said board or any vendor, as defined in section 1 of this  
7 act, shall make a contribution to, or knowingly solicit contributions  
8 from the board's or the executive director's or assistant executive  
9 director's or the vendors' employees or from a subcontractor or  
10 principals of the subcontractor on behalf of (1) an exploratory  
11 committee or candidate committee established by a candidate for  
12 nomination or election to the office of Governor, Lieutenant Governor,  
13 Attorney General, State Comptroller, Secretary of the State or State  
14 Treasurer, (2) a political committee authorized to make contributions  
15 or expenditures to or for the benefit of such candidates, or (3) a party

16 committee.

17 (b) No member of the Connecticut Retirement Security Authority  
 18 board of directors or any executive director, assistant executive  
 19 director or authorized officer appointed by said board or any vendor,  
 20 as defined in section 1 of this act, shall make a contribution to, or  
 21 knowingly solicit contributions from the board's or the executive  
 22 director's or assistant executive director's or the vendors' employees or  
 23 from a subcontractor or principals of the subcontractor on behalf of (1)  
 24 an exploratory committee or candidate committee established by a  
 25 candidate for nomination or election to the office of state senator or  
 26 state representative, (2) a political committee authorized to make  
 27 contributions or expenditures to or for the benefit of such candidates,  
 28 or (3) a party committee."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
