"AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT IN CONNECTICUT."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
4 subparagraph (A) of subdivision (7) of section 12-81 of the general
5 statutes and section 12-87a of the general statutes, any person
6 otherwise eligible for a 2014 grand list exemption pursuant to said
7 subdivision (7) in the city of New Britain, except that such person
8 failed to file the required statement within the time period prescribed,
9 shall be regarded as having filed such statement in a timely manner if
10 such person files such statement not later than thirty days after the
11 effective date of this section and pays the late filing fee pursuant to
12 section 12-87a of the general statutes. Upon confirmation of the receipt
13 of such fee and verification of the exemption eligibility of such

14 property, the assessor shall approve the exemption for such property.
15 If taxes, interest or penalties have been paid on the property for which
16 such exemption is approved, the city of New Britain shall reimburse
17 such person in an amount equal to the amount by which such taxes,
18 interest and penalties exceed any taxes payable if the statement had
19 been filed in a timely manner."
