**"AN ACT CONCERNING A RIGHT TO RESCIND A NURSING HOME CONTRACT."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 19a-539a of the general statutes is amended by adding  
4 subsection (d) as follows (*Effective July 1, 2016*):

5 (NEW) (d) As part of any resident admission agreement, each  
6 nursing home facility shall provide clear and conspicuous notice of the  
7 duties, responsibilities and liabilities of the person or persons who sign  
8 such agreement with the nursing home facility as a responsible party,  
9 including the circumstances under which the responsible party will be  
10 held legally liable and in which such party's personal assets may be  
11 pursued for payment to the facility. Said notice shall be in 14-point

12 bold type and initialed by the responsible party. Failure to include the  
13 notice and obtain the initials of the responsible party or parties shall  
14 render the resident admission agreement unenforceable as to the  
15 responsible party."
