"AN ACT CONCERNING SIGNAGE FOR SITES ON THE CONNECTICUT ANTIQUES TRAIL."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 32-6u of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

5 The Department of Economic and Community Development shall,
6 within available appropriations, establish a Connecticut antiques trail
7 to identify and market sites in the state where antiques are sold. The
8 department shall develop criteria to identify (1) major antique dealers,
9 (2) communities that feature a high concentration of antique dealers,
10 [and] (3) auction houses that have annual sales in excess of one million
11 dollars, and (4) antique dealers located within municipally designated

12 antiques corridors for inclusion in the antiques trail. The department
13 shall develop a program to promote the antiques trail, including, but
14 not limited to, (A) directional and other signs and notices pertaining to
15 the sites identified by the department, and (B) an Internet web site for
16 the antiques trail."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
