**"AN ACT ADJUSTING THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM
ENDING JUNE 30, 2017."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) If the General Assembly has failed
4 to adopt definitions implementing the constitutional spending cap by
5 the required three-fifths vote on or before March 1, 2017, the following
6 salary and other reductions in legislative benefits shall apply and shall
7 remain in effect until such time as such definitions have been adopted
8 by the General Assembly and signed by the Governor:

9 (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 2-9 of the general
10 statutes, the members and officers of the General Assembly shall
11 receive salaries that are ten per cent less than the salaries specified in
12 said section;

13 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 2-15 of the general
14 statutes, no member of the General Assembly shall receive any
15 transportation allowance;

16 (3) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 2-15a of the general
17 statutes, no member of the General Assembly shall be entitled to any
18 unsolicited mailings at the expense of the state; and

19 (4) No member of the General Assembly or legislative employee
20 shall receive payment from the state for any expenses associated with
21 or resulting from attendance at any conference or other meeting in this
22 state or another state or for any other travel related expense."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
