Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE SALE AND PURCHASE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS, ELECTRONIC NICOTINE DELIVERY SYSTEMS AND VAPOR PRODUCTS AND SIGNAGE CONCERNING THE USE OF SUCH PRODUCTS AND SYSTEMS.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) raise the minimum age to twenty-one for the purchase of tobacco products, electronic nicotine delivery systems and vapor products, (2) clarify that "vapor product" does not include a medicinal product used by licensed health care providers to treat patients in a health care setting, and (3) clarify that signs stating that the use of a product or system is prohibited does not need to be placed in every room of a building as long as such signs are posted in a conspicuous place in such building.
