Substitute House Joint Resolution No. 136

The Committee on Judiciary reported through REP. TONG of the 147th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the substitute resolution ought to be adopted.

RESOLUTION VACATING THE DECISION OF THE CLAIMS COMMISSIONER TO DISMISS THE CLAIM AGAINST THE STATE OF DERRICK J. TAYLOR AND REMANDING THE CLAIM TO THE CLAIMS COMMISSIONER FOR A HEARING ON THE MERITS.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That the decision of the Claims Commissioner, file number 23229 of
- 2 said commissioner, ordering the dismissal of the claim against the state
- 3 in excess of twenty thousand dollars of Derrick J. Taylor, is vacated
- 4 and the claim is remanded to the Claims Commissioner for a hearing
- 5 on the merits.
