AN ACT CONCERNING A CAPITOL MEMORIAL FOR WORLD WAR II MERCHANT MARINES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Veterans'
2 Affairs shall, within available appropriations, establish a memorial to
3 honor the members of the Merchant Marine of the United States
4 during the Second World War and place such memorial in a suitable
5 location on the State Capitol grounds.
