The Committee on Education reported through SEN. SLOSSBERG of the 14th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING STATE FUNDING FOR EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Education shall
2 conduct a study relating to state funding for education. Not later than
3 September 30, 2017, the department shall submit a report of the results
4 of such study to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
5 having cognizance of matters relating to education, in accordance with
6 the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
