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I am on Social Security Disability. Every penny counts! Not only because I'm on fixed income, but the State has changed me from Medicaid to "Spend-down" because I got married 2 years ago to a man also on Social Security. Along with that, several years ago the State kept lowering my SNAP amount. No rhyme or reason. Wasn't married at the time and by the time I got married it was down to \$16/month. I am on a "special diet" due to Scleroderma, the reason I am on SSDI. And now I get no SNAP cause I'm married. I can't eat "regular" food like my husband, am supposed to drink 3 Ensure a day but can no longer do that. Healthcare is not important to this State or the Federal Gov't. Years ago, IF one had a doctor's prescription for nutritional drink (generic) it was covered. That was changed with no warning - the only way a person in need of nutritional drink was either be under 18 or have a feeding tube. And I can't afford to buy it, which has caused me to loose a lot of weight and constant fatigue. Taxing SSDI is very UNFAIR!!!
