"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROGRAM OF FAMILY ASSESSMENT RESPONSE."

1 Strike lines 30 to 64, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(4) Not later than July 1, 2016, and annually thereafter, the
4 department shall submit, in accordance with the provisions of section
5 11-4a, a report to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
6 having cognizance of matters relating to children for inclusion in the
7 annual report card prepared pursuant to section 2-53m on the status of
8 the program of family assessment response. Such report shall include
9 data from the previous calendar year, including, but not limited to: (A)
10 The number of accepted reports of child abuse or neglect, and the
11 percentage of reports assigned to the family assessment response track;
12 (B) the disposition of families assigned a family assessment response;
13 (C) for cases assigned to the family assessment response track, a
14 breakdown by reporter type; (D) the number and percentage of family
15 assessment response cases that changed track to investigations; (E) an

16 analysis of the department's prior or subsequent involvement with a
17 family that has been assigned to family assessment response, if
18 applicable; (F) an analysis of the department's prior or subsequent
19 involvement with a family that has be assigned to a community
20 partner agency; (G) a description of services that are commonly
21 provided to families referred to the community support for families
22 program; (H) a description of the department's staff development and
23 training practices relating to intake; (I) the number and percentage of
24 referred families who were ultimately enrolled in the community
25 support for families program; (J) the number and percentage of
26 families receiving a family assessment response broken down by race
27 and ethnicity; (K) the reason for discharge from the community
28 support for families program broken down by race and ethnicity; and
29 (L) a comparison of the needs identified and the needs addressed for
30 families referred to the community support for families program."
