 - 3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (d) of section 22a-245 of the general statutes is

4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
5 *1, 2016*):

6 (d) (1) In addition to the refund value of a beverage container, a
7 distributor shall pay to any dealer or operator of a redemption center a
8 handling fee of at least one and one-half cents for each container of
9 beer or other malt beverage, and two cents for each beverage container
10 of mineral [waters] water, soda water and similar carbonated soft
11 drinks or noncarbonated beverage returned for redemption. A
12 distributor shall not be required to pay to a manufacturer the refund
13 value of a nonrefillable beverage container.

14 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (1) of this
15 subsection, on and after July 1, 2016, a distributor shall pay to any
16 operator of a redemption center that is not located on the same
17 premises of a retail establishment a handling fee of at least three and
18 one-half cents for each beverage container of beer or other malt
19 beverage, mineral water, soda water and similar carbonated soft
20 drinks or noncarbonated beverage returned for redemption."
