**"AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE TRANSIT CORRIDOR  
DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE AUTHORITY."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2016*) (a) For the purposes of this section,  
4 "municipality" means any town, city, borough, consolidated town and  
5 city or consolidated town and borough, and "transit-oriented  
6 development" and "public transportation facilities" have the same  
7 meanings as provided in section 13b-79kk of the general statutes.

8 (b) The Office of Policy and Management shall establish a pilot  
9 program to (1) facilitate new investment and economic and transit-  
10 oriented development through cooperation and coordination with the  
11 municipalities wherein such public transportation facilities are located;  
12 (2) stimulate tourism, art, culture, history, education and

13 entertainment through cooperation and coordination with such  
 14 municipalities, regional organizations and the Department of  
 15 Economic and Community Development; and (3) manage facilities  
 16 through contractual agreement or other legal instrument. The Office of  
 17 Policy and Management shall develop and issue a request for  
 18 proposals from individual municipalities. Each proposal shall  
 19 demonstrate the ability of the applying municipality to support such  
 20 transit-oriented development by accessing funds matching or  
 21 exceeding the amount sought in the request for proposal.

22 (c) If the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, or the  
 23 secretary's designee, determines that a proposal is viable, the secretary  
 24 shall establish the pilot program in such municipality, monitor the  
 25 implementation of the pilot program and access the results of the pilot  
 26 program."
