"AN ACT INCREASING ACCESS TO OVERDOSE REVERSAL DRUGS."

1 In section 7, strike subsection (c) and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "(c) When issuing a prescription for an opioid drug to a minor
4 patient for the first time, a prescribing practitioner who is authorized
5 to prescribe an opioid drug shall not issue a prescription for more than
6 a three-day supply of such drug. When issuing a prescription for an
7 opioid drug to a minor patient, the prescribing practitioner shall
8 discuss the risks associated with use of an opioid drug and the reasons
9 why the prescription is necessary with (1) the minor, and (2) the

10 custodial parent, guardian or other person having legal custody of the
11 minor if such parent, guardian or other person is present at the time of
12 issuance."
